

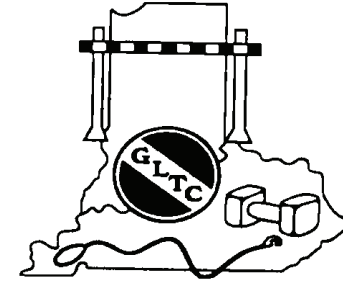

**AKC's "Random Draw" Method of Accepting Entries**

\*\*\*\*\*

**Chapter 1 Section 13:** "Random Draw" - Clubs must set an "opening period" which shall not be less than a seven (7) day period ( 14 days recommended). The opening period shall have a start time and date, and finish time and date.

Entries received prior to a published date and time that entries would first be accepted shall be considered invalid entries, and be returned as expeditiously as possible.

To ensure a successfully run trial at clubs who choose the "Random Draw" entry method, the show giving club may at its option guarantee an entry spot in the trial for dogs of "Show Workers" that have agreed to work at the trial. All other entries received during the opening period shall be treated equally without regard to date received or any other criteria. A random drawing of all entries received during the opening period shall be held within 48 hours after the "opening period" has ended, to determine which dogs will participate in the trial. If the advertised limit has not been reached the remainder of the entry limit shall be filled by entries received after the "opening period" but before the final closing date based on a "first received" premise.

**A maximum of ten (10) entries is allowed in each envelope submitted to the trial secretary for random draw. Each dog entered is considered a separate entry regardless of the quantity of classes that dog is entered in. Envelopes exceeding the 10 maximum entries shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.**

The drawing shall be held in a public place and open to all interested persons. The results of the draw shall be made available to the people present at the draw. In conducting the drawing for entries, the trial secretary shall avoid any method that raises any questions as to its randomness and impartiality.

The trial secretary will conduct the draw on the date, hour, and at the location specified for such in the premium list. Envelopes shall be drawn at random and entries contained within each envelope shall gain entry to the trial up to the entry limits specified in the premium list.

If an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, then there shall be a random draw of the individual entries has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn for a position on the alternate's list. If the advertised limit has not been reached, the remainder of the entry limit shall be filled by entries received after the "opening period", but before the final closing date based on a "First received" premise. The final closing date shall not be less than fourteen (14) days prior to the trial.

**Do NOT call** the secretary the night of the draw to see if your entry has been accepted. The secretary WILL be happy to answer e-mail requests or return self addressed, stamped cards, with check boxes to verifying that the entry has been accepted.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

## **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

## **CLASSES OFFERED**

All regular and preferred Standard and JWW will be offered on all days. In addition, ISC classes will be offered on Friday and Saturday. Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

## **HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All dogs except 24" must be measured before being shown if a height card has not been presented. If a rep or VMO is present than all dogs must show a card or be measured.

### **Regular class Preferred class**

8 inches.... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.... 4"  
12 inches.... For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.... 8"  
16 inches.... For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.... 12"  
20 inches.... For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.... 16"  
24 inches.... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers..... 20"  
26 inches.... at owners discretion – A-frame set to 5'7"

## **OBSTACLES**

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials. Equipment by Max 200.

## **AGILITY REGULATIONS**

**Express Mail Entries** \*must\* include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to the sender.

**Bitches in Season** will not be admitted to the Trial. Any Exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the Trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$15.00 (for each day entered), upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary not later than 8:00 AM on the day of the Trial.

**Make Checks and Money Orders Payable** (for all 4 trials) to **Greater Louisville Training Club CANADIAN Exhibitors** must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. GLTC assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

**Post Dated or Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check.

**No Entry Shall be Made** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Errors on Entry Forms.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please TYPE or **Print Carefully** the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

**PLEASE include instructions** as to what you wish to do with your entry if you can not get in all the classes and days you entered.

**Entries Will Be Acknowledged** as soon as possible after the entry is received if you include a legible e-mail address or postcard. **Entries Will Be Acknowledged After Entries Close** with identification cards and Judging Program. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Secretary.

Entry Fees Shall Not Be Refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused Judge, or barred from competition by action of Agility Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Exhibitors Must Be Governed by Any Rules or Regulations of civil authorities, the KY Fairgrounds, GLTC Show Committee and/or building or location restrictions. Dogs Must be Ready for Judging. The Club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. All Dogs Present must be Held on Leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the warm-up area.

NO GROOMING will be allowed in the agility crating area.

Due to possible crating space limitations, exhibitors might need to consolidate their crating space.
