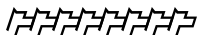

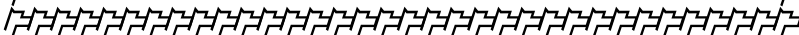

## PHILADELPHIA BENCHING ~ BOTH DAYS

By order of the Fire Marshal, crates will not be allowed in the aisles of benching or show sections of the shows. Space will be provided in the benching section for the cleaning and preparation of dogs for exhibition. Grooming tables in excess of 24" x 36" will not be permitted. Tables must be folded when not in use. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the benching area is not permitted either day. Private Exercise pens MUST have plastic underneath and around the bottom. NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS WILL BE PERMITTED BETWEEN 8:00 A.M. & 6:00 P.M. These Regulations will be strictly enforced.



## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

### EACH DAY IS A BENCHED SHOW

All dogs must arrive by 11:00 A.M.

**Dogs WILL NOT be excused during benching hours (8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. Saturday & 8:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. Sunday)**

They are not permitted to leave the building e.g. if a breed has completed judging at 9:00 A.M. the dogs are required to go to the benching area for the remainder of the day and be available to meet the public.

A bench audit will be conducted. Once inside the building during show hours, no dog may exit until after 5:00 P.M. on Saturday or 3:00 P.M. on Sunday. Dogs present must be on their assigned benches, except for the necessary periods when they are actually being prepared for showing, or are being shown, or are in the exercise pen, or are being taken to or from these places. This will be enforced! Violations of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee, which may result in cancellation of the dog's winnings and subject the owner or handler to further action by the American Kennel Club.

**Building Access:**

**Exhibitors may enter the building until 11:00 P.M.**

The building will be **locked between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:30 A.M. each night.** No one will be allowed access to the building during these hours.

**Between 5:00 P.M. and 11:00 P.M. SATURDAY, dogs may be removed for exercising with proper identification.** Security guards will be on duty. On Saturday and Sunday, admission stub for each dog must be surrendered upon entrance to building and remaining stub upon exit. This will be enforced both days.

**All dogs must enter and exit through Exhibitors' Entrance.**

**Surrender of identification card** must be made to the check clerk for removing dogs from the show.

**PUBLICATION RIGHTS:** By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

# NOTICE                      IMPORTANT                      NOTICE

The Philadelphia style benching concept was conceived by former Kennel Club of Philadelphia President, L. Stewart Cochrane to make the benched show more comfortable, convenient and attractive to all exhibitors and spectators. **NOTE:** There will be **NO separate grooming areas**. All grooming will be done at the assigned benches. There will be **NO private exercise pens in benching area**. **Exercise pens will be provided at several locations**. There may be some room in Hall E for private exercise pens if needed, **must be approved by Show Chair or Site Control**. Plastic for the floor shavings and clean up will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

1. All dogs entered **by an owner/exhibitor or agent/handler** can be benched together. If you are an exhibitor/agent and you wish to have all your dogs benched together, you **MUST** make a request in writing. This request **MUST** include your name(s), MB-F Agent's Number, the AKC registration number, and breeds of those dogs you want benched together. This request **MUST** be received by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries. **A form is included on page 7** of this premium list for your convenience. **Multi-breed benching requests must have the same ownership or handler name and number**.
2. A special index will be included in the Judging Program to help you locate your benching area. The Superintendent will provide name signs on benches and rows for quick identification of benching areas.
3. All exhibitors and agents will be permitted to have their **grooming equipment only** immediately in front of their respective benches. There will be **no separate areas for grooming or crates**. Stacking of crates on benches will not be permitted, except in the case of Toy Breeds. By order of the Fire Marshal, crates will not be permitted in any aisle, at any ring or on any floor space. All crates **MUST** be on the benching.
4. Bench numbers will not be permitted to be changed or altered in any manner.
5. All dogs must be benched in accordance with "Notice to all Exhibitors" on **page 5**. **Once a dog is admitted into the show building it cannot leave until the normal release time when benching hours are concluded each day**. This will be strictly enforced by the Superintendent and the Event Committee.
6. The Superintendent will provide Handlers/Agents in the Multi-Breed sections only with name signs on their benches and rows for quick identification of their benching area.
7. **Electricity for grooming will be provided by The Kennel Club of Philadelphia, Inc.** However, only one appliance can be connected to each outlet at one time. Additional appliances on a single circuit will cause an overload. Exhibitors will be charged to reactivate a circuit.

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise noted below. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated below and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

**NOTE: Spayed Bitches & Neutered Dogs are NOT eligible to exhibit in Veteran Classes**

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES & SATURDAY - PEKINGESE

*NR1.08100.15000. Veteran Classes* - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years & over.

#### SATURDAY & SUNDAY - BOSTON TERRIERS

*NR1.08100.20800. Veteran Classes* - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years & under ten (10) years.

*NR1.08100.37100. Veteran Classes* - Class for dogs & class for bitches ten (10) years & over.

#### SATURDAY - CHESAPEAKE BAY RETRIEVERS

*NR1.08100.27400. Veteran Classes* - Class for dogs & class for bitches eight (8) years & over.

#### SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES

*NR1.08900. Sled Dog Classes* - Requirements for Sled Dog Classes are listed below and must receive strict adherence. No deviation from the rules allowed.

1. Entry must be an AKC or CKC registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, of the AKC Rules regarding Registration and Dog Shows).
2. There will be a class for dogs & a class for bitches.
3. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
  - a.) During the previous racing season, each entry must have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of five (5) miles per heat or seventy (70) miles of competition. All races must be on snow with sleds & under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31.
  - b.) Entries have completed five (5) years in competition where the above requirements have been met shall be automatically qualified for Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the five (5) years of proof of competition records are sent in.
  - c.) Entries who have been awarded a SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
4. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

#### SATURDAY - CHESAPEAKE BAY RETRIEVERS

*NR1.21800. Hunting Retriever Classes* - Class for dogs & class for bitches who have earned an AKC Hunting Retriever title.

#### 00900. BEST OF BREED (01000. VARIETY) COMPETITION

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES

*NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class* - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

*NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class* - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety Competition by virtue of having won these classes.

## SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES

**NR2.09300. Brace Class - Two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.** - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

### INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

**Telegraph, Telephone (Except Dial-N-Entry®) and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms, Downloaded and/or Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

**Mail All Entries With Fees to MB-F, Inc., Superintendent, P.O. Box 22107, Greensboro, North Carolina 27420. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.** Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor** within a reasonable time, please verify your entry with the MB-F Office in North Carolina.

Fax entries must be received by the closing hour/date. Fax fee: \$4.95 per entry in addition to entry fee. **Make All Checks and Money Orders** payable to MB-F, Inc. **CANADIAN/FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.

**An AKC Recording Fee of \$5.00 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$2.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their bench except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

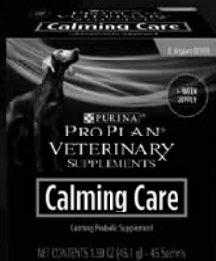
